Report on the audit of the Financial Results

Opinion

We have audited the accompanying statement of financial results of Shilchar Technologies Limited (the company) for quarter and year ended 31st March, 2022 (the "Statement"), attached herewith, being submitted by the company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("Listing Regulations").
